YELLOW CARD REGULATION

1. Yellow Card

The “Yellow Card” is used to warn players and to report and record their undesirable behaviour as listed in Sec. 2 hereunder. The card will contain relevant details of the incident, including the names of the players involved.

2. Issuance of Yellow Card

A card will be issued by a TD under any of the following circumstances:

- a) All cases where there is a violation of Law 74 (Conduct and Etiquette).
- b) Violation or potential violation of Laws 73 or 89.

3. Use of the Card

The card issued must be clearly shown and explained to the participant and given to a TD or official designated for this purpose. A full record will be maintained in a confidential repository readily available to the Championship Committee and its designees.

4. Further action to be taken

- a) Notification of a card issued will be sent to the captain (in a team event)
- b) Behaviour of a participant or an occurrence which in the opinion of the TD may require further action in addition to the issuance of a Card and should be reported immediately to the Championship Committee or Investigations Committee.
- c) Instances of 2(b) or of unethical behaviour should also be reported to a recorder designated by the Championship Committee.
- d) The Championship Committee will be advised and will take any action it deems appropriate when a participant has received two or more Cards over the course of the tournament.
- e) At the end of the tournament, a listing with details of Cards issued will be submitted to the Championship Committee or its designee for future reference.
